“Pale yellow color with notes of lime, grapefruit, apricot, nectarine, and green apple, complemented by a flinty minerality. Petrol, green grapes, elderflower, geranium, are augmented by bright acidity, and a dry, structured complexity.”

“Tart apricot and barely there petrol aromas introduce this as a Riesling for people who love Riesling. Restrained and silky, the wine carries currents of grapefruit zest and wet slate into a long, savory finish.
