2018

"A flavorful, savory pinot with ripe dark cherries and raspberries, roasted licorice, coca cola, wet earth and dried roses. A very smooth pinot with fresh but naturally rendered acidity that gives it a supple and composed feel. Long, with lots of roses and forest-berries in the finish. From organically grown grapes with Ecocert certification. A joy to drink now."

2017

"The 2017 EQ Granite Pinot Noir had a more traditional vinification after they gained a better understanding of their vineyard, which has been worked biodynamically since it was planted. There is a meat and iron note here that gives it character; it has a soft texture and very fine tannins. It has balance and freshness, and you forget you are tasting a 2017."

"Aromas of raspberries, dried cherries, spices, orange-zest, cocoa and minerals. It's medium-to full-bodied with mellow, ripe tannins. Round, rich and creamy with savory character in the mouth. Flavorful and balanced with a delicious finish. Drink now or hold."

"...Light red in the glass. The nose opens with cherry and earth aromas, followed by hints of mushroom. Beautifully intense, it is lean in the mouth with active tannins and a gentle freshness. A flavorful Pinot delivering the tense concentration typical of Coastal Range granite soils."

"There is a clear step up in complexity and depth compared with the Corralillo and also more freshness, from a vineyard that has contained yields and has more influence from the sea. This is simply delicious, with notes of sour cherries, a spicy twist and a focused and delineated palate from the shallow granite soils."

"A warm and fruity red with plum, berry and strawberry character. Medium-to-full body, medium tannins and a fresh and bright finish. Drink or hold."

"Very bright and flamboyant aromas of crushed raspberry and blueberry. Hints of spice. Medium to full body, fine tannins and a fruity, savory character. Whole berry and 25% stems in fermentation and maceration. Fruit-forward in a subtle way. Drink now. Made from biodynamic grapes."
