Free-flowing with refined, grippy tannins, it's potent and juicy in the mouth with a finish of intricate flavor. This is a strong blend tailored to suit the year."

- **92** – JAMES SUCKLING, *March 23, 2022*

"Notes of mulberries, dark plums, chocolate, toasted hazelnuts and baking spices. Full-bodied with fine tannins. Fruity and layered with a rich, flavorful finish...drink or hold."

- **91** – VINOUS, *November 18, 2021*

"...The complex nose presents notes of plum and violets with hints of blackcurrant, balsam and country herbs over aromas from the aging process. It's compact in the mouth with a juicy, fresh flow and some grip and volume before the balsamic finish."

"Big, wild blackberries with delicate spice and vanilla notes, lead you into a bold and well structured red with a long, moderately dry finish...Drink or hold."

2016

"This young Malbec shows some vanilla character and hints of raspberries. Medium to full body, round tannins and a vibrant and lively finish. Should come around with some age but a little too much now. Drink in 2019."
