# • 92 - JAMES SUCKLING, March 2024

"Wild cherries, crushed stone, raspberries and coriander on the nose. Sleek and focused with a full body and tightknit tannins. Mineral finish. Drink or hold."

#### 2019

- **94 VINOUS**, November 2022
- "...A dark garnet red in the glass. The reserved, layered nose presents notes of blackcurrant, blueberry and green and black pepper over a bed of oak. In the mouth, it's medium-bodied with a compact flow and firm, refined tannins that add depth. A complex style that will improve in the bottle..."

- "Notes of dark cherries, wild berries, violets and dry earth. Toasted hazelnuts, vanilla and grilled herbs, too. Full-bodied with fine-grained tannins and a fleshy texture. Lots of flavor. Supple, textured and lengthy finish. Drink or hold."

## • 92 - JAMES SUCKLING, April 2020

"This is a big, rich cabernet with lots of currants and chewy, velvety tannins that are long and intense. A mouthful, but ever so polished and pretty. Drink after 2021."

"This dark, fully ripe Cabernet opens with earthy berry and black plum aromas and a touch of warmth on the nose. A full palate is softened by creamy oak, while blackberry and cassis flavors come with chocolaty oak notes."

# • 91 - VINOUS, October 2020

"Up until this year, the style of Particular was dominated by the wood, but that is beginning to change. The entirety of this wine was aged for 12 months in 70% new oak. Intense in color, with a nose of black currant and hints of pyrazine and mint, along with clear, slightly smoky wood notes that provide structure. The medium body is supported by active tannins and tangible grip, softened by the low freshness..."
