- "... Spicy and fresh, this has a tinge of vanilla followed by red fruits. As always with this grape, the freshness surrounds and lifts the fruit. Then, Vallado gives it serious treatment and the tannins come out to play. The mid-palate finesse is exceptional. The piquant finish has a touch of garrigue and strawberry. I am shocked at how good this bottling (which I wasn't originally sure I would like) has become, not just on occasion, but regularly...A little nervy and a little tight, it won't necessarily be everyone's first choice, but it is becoming pretty special if its style is your style. In structure, Barolo fans may particularly admire it. In flavor, perhaps the Southern Rhône fans will take notice. That's an interesting blend of styles..."
