“So delicious. Tangy and juicy with ripe and beautiful fruit, such as strawberries and cherries, as well as perfume and chocolate. Full body, round tannins and a delicious finish. Drink now or hold.”

- **90 Pts.** – *Vinous, Oct. 2019*

“Opaque ruby. Pungent dark berry, cherry and licorice aromas show good clarity and pick up a peppery accent in the glass. Broad and fleshy in the mouth, offering nicely concentrated blueberry and bitter cherry flavors that turn sweeter with air. The blue fruit note carries through a long, juicy finish that's framed by smooth, harmonious tannins.”

2017

- **94 Pts.** – James Suckling, *Dec. 21, 2018*

“This is wild, offering plums, spices and brown tea. Violets, too. Full-bodied, tannic and very structured. Yet, it turns polished and velvety at the finish. Gorgeous. Drink or hold.”

- **90 Pts.** – *Wine Spectator, Dec. 21, 2018*

“This supple, light-bodied red packs cherry, red currant and raspberry fruit, edged by floral and tangy elements, with a glossy texture. Ample licorice and spice details linger into the long finish. Drink now through 2024. 300 cases made, 110 cases imported.”

2016

- **91 Pts.** – ‘Cellar Selection’ - *Wine Enthusiast, March 1, 2018*

“This estate is named for the Romans who originally planted vines here. With touches of wood aging giving spice and toast along with rich, juicy black-plum fruits, this is a wine to age. It will be best from 2019.”

- **90 Pts.** – James Suckling, *Feb. 22, 2018*

“A dense Beaujolais with spices, flowers and plenty of oak. Full to medium body, firm tannins and a juicy finish. Needs time to soften. A touch too much new wood. But still impressive. Try in 2020.”

2015

“From five different parcels in Moulin-à-Vent, this cru wine is a structured representative of the appellation. With some wood aging, the wine has gained extra richness to add to the generous black currant and berry fruits. Drink this concentrated wine from 2019.”

- **92 Pts.** – James Suckling, *Feb. 10, 2017*

“This is really pretty with flowers, berries, stones and rose granite. Medium-to full-bodied, super tight and polished. Ripe fruit yet it's all in balance. About one year in two-year-old oak barrels. Drink or hold.”
