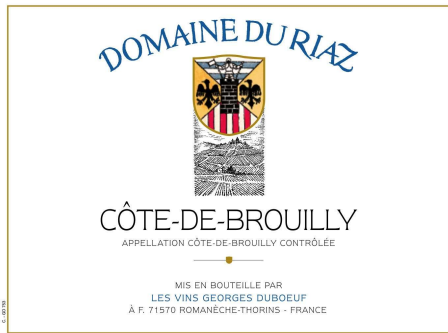

“Gorgeous wine from this appellation with orange peel, cherries, dried strawberries and ripe watermelon. Complex. The palate is extraordinary, delivering a wonderful center palate of fruit. Great drive that pops at the end with citrus fruit and cherries. Firm tannins, too.”

2017 –

“A juicy, rich red with plum and berry character and an underscore of juicy cherries and orange peel. Medium to full body and a round, flavorful finish. Bigger style to this. Drink now.”

2016 –

• **91 Pts.** – James Suckling, *Feb. 2018*

“Very fruity and fragrant nose with poached strawberries. There are also plenty of lively red fruits on the palate. A little chew here. Drink now or hold.”

• **90 Pts.** – *Vinous*, *March 2018*

“Deep brilliant ruby. Spice-accented dark fruit, violet and white pepper aromas on the deeply perfumed nose. Energetic cassis and bitter cherry flavors are lifted and given structure by a spine of juicy acidity. The dark fruit note drives the gently tannic finish, which hangs on with strong tenacity.

• **90 Pts.** ‘Best Buy’ – *Wine & Spirits*, *October, 2017*

“This has the clean, juicy gloss of a Duboeuf wine, but give it time to get past that cherry-red brightness and darker notes emerge in lean, mineral inflected tannins. Fragrant, with some stuffing, it’s serious enough to warrant a year or two in the cellar.”

2015 –

• **92 Pts.** James Suckling, *Feb. 11, 2017*

“Love the complexity of aromas of dark berry, chocolate and cream. Medium body, tight and juicy tannin in the mid-palate and a long and flavorful finish. Linear and polished. Very refined Côte-de-Brouilly. Drink now.”

• **91 Pts.** – *Vinous*, *January 2017*

“Vivid purple. Sexy, highly perfumed aromas of fresh dark berries, violet and licorice, joined in the glass by a spicy nuance. Sweet and seamless in texture, offering concentrated black raspberry and blueberry flavors that tighten up slowly on the back half. Finishes very long and sappy, displaying repeating spiciness and a touch of smoky minerality. Shows the richness of the vintage but comes off lithe and polished, with no rough edges.”

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
