## MAGDALENA TOSO “Highlights”

2017

- 93 – WINE SPECTATOR, *November 30, 2019*

“Fleshy, powerful and full of unctuous dried blueberry, blackberry and plum tart flavors that are interwoven with notes of cocoa powder and savory spice. Sanguine elements emerge midpalate, leading to a long finish that lingers with hints of freshly ground white pepper. Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon.”

“The winery ferments two Cabernet Sauvignon and two Malbec lots separately, then selects the best barrels to make the ultimate blend in a stainless steel tank): Bright, dark ruby. Very suave aromas of blackberry, boysenberry and spices complemented by oak tones of tar and coffee. The richest and silkiest of this line-up from Pascual Toso, offering lovely sweetness and generosity of texture.”

“Getting all the possible stereotypes together, with a huge bottle and price tag, lavish new oak and ripe fruit, the 2016 Magdalena Toso is one of those “author” wines from the 1990s, where the hand of the winemaker and the élevage tend to eclipse everything else. It's 68% Malbec and 32% Cabernet Sauvignon dominated by the 18 months in French barriques, I guess mostly new. For fans of the style who also have deep pockets. 8,000 bottles were filled in December 2017.”

“The interplay between intensity and subtlety is an enticing one with blackberry perfume, crushed violets, sugar plums, licorice and tar. Similarly, on the palate look to the crunchy acidity and fine-grained tannins that sit well with the bold blue fruit. A blend of 68% malbec and 32% cabernet sauvignon. Drink in 2020.”
