“Inky magenta. Expansive, oak-spiced black and blue fruits, incense, vanilla, licorice and woodsmoke on the powerfully scented nose. Plush and appealingly sweet, offering concentrated kirsch, blackberry, fruitcake and vanilla flavors that possess unlikely energy for their heft. The dark berry and floral notes return on the impressively long finish, which is framed by smooth, well-knit tannins...”

“Presents a core of juicy apricot, black cherry preserve and huckleberry notes that are concentrated and have terrific purity, with dried herb and floral accents. The exuberant finish features notes of black tea and spice. Drink now through 2040.”
