- **91 – JAMES SUCKLING**, *May 20, 2025*

"This has a vivid, red-fruited character with spiced cherries, red licorice, dried citrus peel and a hint of moist earth. The palate is tense and savory, with medium body and firm, lightly chewy tannins. Lingering, mineral finish. Try after 2027."

2020

- **93 – WINE ENTHUSIAST**, *August 2024*

"Stunningly beautiful, this Barolo effortlessly balances succulent fruit and enchanting herbal notes in a mesmerizing dance. Ample flavors of ripe red cherries, juicy strawberries, and raspberries fill the mouth, while delicate hints of thyme, rosemary, and mint add an intriguing complexity. The wine builds to a captivating crescendo, leaving you craving more. Drink now - 2040."

- **92 – JAMES SUCKLING**, *October 25, 2023*

"Spiced and red-fruited with notes of dried herbs, licorice, nutmeg and sandalwood. Medium-bodied with fresh, slightly more mellow fruit and a creamy texture to the tannins. Sleek and polished. Flavorful finish. Better after 2-3 years."

2019

- **92 – JAMES SUCKLING**, *November 2023*

"Notes of ripe red berries, dark chocolate, sweet spices and moist earth. Medium- to full-bodied, textured and velvety with compact tannins and a dense structure. Lingering and firm. Try after 2026."

2018

- **93 – WINE ADVOCATE**, *December 2022*

"Monvigliero is one of the most sought-after vineyard sites in Barolo today. The Bel Colle 2018 Barolo Monvigliero shows balanced intensity with dried fruit, earth, crushed white pepper, licorice and crushed rose. The wine is complete, thanks to its balanced acidity and integrated tannins. This is the most elegant of the Barolos presented from this estate."

- **91 – JAMES SUCKLING**, *April 20, 2022*

"Some complexity to the nose with red berries, walnuts and dried-flower notes. Loses some of the interest on the fluid, medium-bodied palate, but there is still some intensity and focus. The tannins play a minor role. Try from 2023."

- **90 – WINE ENTHUSIAST**, *October 2022 Issue*

"This opens with aromas of cedar, mocha and baked plum. The ripe palate offers blackberry jam, tobacco and toasted hazelnut alongside close-grained tannins. Drink 2024-2030."

"Rich, laced with cherry, strawberry and floral notes, this Barolo remains vibrant and firmly structured. Accents of licorice, iron, tobacco and tar lend complexity, while the finish exhibits serious grip. All the elements are present, so be patient."
