


EPONYMOUS CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2023

TASTING NOTES: Eponymous Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon with a deep, inky purple hue opens with layered aromas of ripe plum, blackberry, cassis, and subtle floral notes of violet. Hints of toasted rosemary and dark chocolate add complexity. On the palate, the wine is rich and expressive, showcasing vibrant fruit, balanced structure, and supple tannins that lead to a long, polished finish.

WINEMAKER NOTES: The 2023 blend reflects meticulous sourcing from Napa Valley's most revered appellations: Cabernet Sauvignon (97%) forms the backbone, complemented by Petit Verdot (1.6%), and Malbec (1.4%). Grapes hail primarily from Yountville, Napa Valley, Oak Knoll District, and Howell Mountain, with select contributions from Alexander Valley for added depth. Aged 16 months in 100% French oak barrels.

FAMILY: Founded in 2000 by Robert "Bob" Pepi, Eponymous Wines embodies creativity and resilience. After selling his namesake winery in 1994, Bob reclaimed his identity through the name "Eponymous," meaning "one for whom something is named." Today, the brand continues to honor his vision of crafting exceptional wines from Napa and Sonoma's finest vineyards.

Eponymous Wines proudly moves forward under the guidance of winemaker Derek Irwin, blending a fresh perspective with a deep respect for Bob Pepi's legacy. Derek's global experience and dedication to balance and vibrancy ensure that Eponymous remains a benchmark for Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon.
