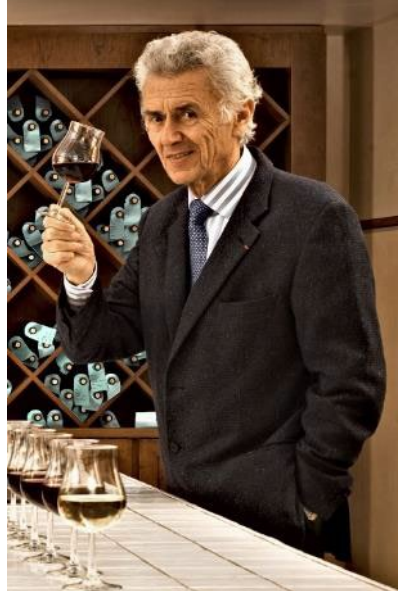
For **more than four centuries**, the Duboeuf family has been producing wine. Georges, who passed away in January, 2020 at age 86, was well-known for his dynamism, created *Les Vins Georges Duboeuf* in September of 1964. This historical date also marked the start of his wine merchant business -- selecting, bottling and selling fine French wines from the Beaujolais and Mâconnais regions of Burgundy. In the process, Georges and his wines became world famous.

In essence, Georges was the ambassador of the region...loyal to his quest of offering quality wines, combining the flavor profiles of their terroir with bold characters. He conducted his business by negotiating with heart, passion and the constant desire to share the very best of Beaujolais. In continuing the family tradition, Georges' son Franck runs the family business, with his son Aurélien recently taking a role on the winemaking side, his nephew Adrien on the business side, and Franck's wife Anne managing the unique "wine-centric" museum, botanical gardens and family-friendly amusement park, Le Hameau Duboeuf.

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Lieu-Dit Wines

Directly translated to “placed-called”, the Lieu-Dit collection highlights a parcel of vines that has been given special recognition because of its topography or its history. The uniqueness and quality that the terroir expresses in this place is reflected in the wine, vintage after vintage, thanks to the winemaker’s know-how.

La Madrone is named after a little chapel built at the top of the highest hill in Fleurie (pictured above).

Côte du Py is the most famous lieu-dit of Morgon, the flagship Cru of Beaujolais.



Bourgogne Wines

The Bourgogne collection represents the prestigious wine region with a cool climate and predominantly clay and limestone soils. Burgundy offers fine wines, which wonderfully express the mosaic of terroirs from which they come.

The Chardonnay and Gamay selections of regional appellation wines is an invitation to discover the clear-cut varietal character.





Pays d'Oc
FRANCE



Produced by Georges Dubœuf, the Varietal Wines represent the best expression of each region with a touch of sunshine from the South of France in every sip.

Wildflowers bloom in the fields and vineyards of the Pays d'Oc region that lies between lush mountains and the deep blue Mediterranean sea. The Pays d'Oc region benefits from a climate that is ideal for growing grapes.

Each of the wildflowers pictured on the labels corresponds to a specific flower that is found in the region.

- Scabiosa – Cabernet Sauvignon - Full bodied, smooth with notes of cherry, spice and a touch of vanilla.
- Cornflower – Merlot - Rich, ruby color bursting with dark velvety fruit, notes of chocolate and tobacco, smooth, lingering finish.
- Red Poppy – Pinot Noir - Notes of ripe cherry and bright strawberry with an elegant mouth-feel and soft finish.
- Yellow Gentian - Chardonnay - Bright and crisp notes of apple, pear and lemon peel with a creamy body and refreshing finish.
