

SAMUEL CHARLES PASO ROBLES CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2023

Paso Robles, California



TASTING NOTES: Notes of red plum and cranberry, paired with hints of vanilla lingering in the background. The French oak used for aging shines on the palate, with a burst of pomegranate swiftly transitioning to supple spice and tannin structure. Enjoy with roasted vegetables, grilled fare, aged cheeses, and the company of family and friends.

WINEMAKER NOTES: Samuel Charles strives to make a Cabernet Sauvignon that speaks to the region of Paso Robles. Pulling from vineyards in some of Paso's most prestigious sub AVAs, we believe this blend is a true homage to Paso Robles Cabernet. The beautiful soils and diurnal temperature swings in Paso allow for bright natural acid to express itself on the palate, alongside aromas of wet stone and ripe red fruits.

FAMILY: Like the Stag, a large male deer indigenous to Europe but now found as far away as Argentina and New Zealand, Cabernet Sauvignon and Sauvignon Blanc have taken root in vineyards across most of the New World. The symbol best represents the melding old world varietals and basic winemaking techniques with New World technology and innovation. These wines are truly the 'best of both worlds.'

Renowned Napa Valley winemaker Robert Pepi is the magician behind these stellar wines. Grapes for the Oak Knoll Cabernet Sauvignon come from a vineyard located on the benchlands of the Mayacamas Mountain Range, where the region's best terrior is found. The Sauvignon Blanc grapes are grown in the High Valley AVA of Lake County, CA. At nearly 2,000 feet elevation, they are some of the highest and best Sauvignon Blanc vineyards in the state.

The label is named after Dennis Kreps' two sons. It expresses the great pride he has in them as well as the wines.
